Exploding fireworks are illegal in Florida and current drought conditions present an additional hazard.

Under Florida law, only novelty-type fireworks are legal for consumer usage, and anything that flies in the air or explodes is illegal. This year, due to a mandatory burn ban, **NO FIREWORK USAGE WILL BE PERMITTED AT ANY TIME**, except for currently scheduled professional displays. Using illegal fireworks is a first-degree misdemeanor punishable by up to one year in jail and a \$1,000 fine. (Section 791.04 of Chapter 791, Florida Statutes). Considering current drought conditions, please take extra care with outdoor cooking and cigarette disposal.
